Primary PE and Sport Premium: Key Indicators

Schools should use the funding to make additional and sustainable improvements to the quality of PE and Sport they offer.

There are 5 key indicators that the school should expect to see improvement across:

- The engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity
- The profile of PE and Sport is raised across the school as a tool for whole school improvement.
- Increased confidence, knowledge, and skills of all staff in teaching PE and Sport
- Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils.
- Increased participation in competitive sport

Orchard Manor PE and School Sport Review

Over the last few years there has been an amalgamation of two special schools to form one school: Orchard Manor.

This has necessitated many changes to existing programmes and delivery, but across the whole school there is now excellent teaching of PE, and when COVID allowed, increased programmes for pupils to access other opportunities. The PE and School Sport Premium have been used very effectively to support these changes and improvements. The Head of PE has since retired, and a new teacher has been appointed. It is her ambition to continue to drive PE and Sport forward in the school and to use the funding to enable the vision of outstanding PE and Sport provision to be achieved.

The new Head of PE has identified 5 target areas to focus on throughout this first year as well as continuing the ongoing work. These targets will be reflected in the following documentation regarding the intended use of the 2020-2021 PE and School Sport Premium use. Costs are predicted on the document.

Target areas are:

- Developing Sports Leader programme across the whole school to raise aspirations and increase opportunities.
- Establish "Orchard Manor Girls Can" groups to promote positive attitudes around physical activity in a male dominated environment.
- Increase access to high quality PESSPA for all pupils.
- Raise fitness levels.
- Develop the schools' facilities.

Due to the nature of the school, 95% of the pupils travel to school by taxi and therefore all activity needs to be done within existing school hours.

Funding carryover from 2019-2020 is £5000, and expected allocation this year will be £16,300. Total spend expected as £21,300.
